His discourses are motivating and excellent. He talks about the form and glory of the Lord. He also talks about the ways to become free from small or big vices in life. He also talks about how to become an absolute devotee. Shree Hari has talked about all these things in His discourses at various places. Most of these sermons are delivered in the courtyard of Dada Khachar at Gadhada. Rest were delivered at Sarangpur, Kariyani, Loya, Panchala, Amdavad and Vadtal. Lord Swaminarayan delivered twenty vachnamruts at Vadtal. I would like to explore them here.

In the first vachnamrut of Vadtal, Shree Shobharam Shastri, a learned scholar of Vadodara, asked Shreeji Maharaj, 'O great Lord! When an aspirant attains Nirvikalpa Samadhi (absolute superconscious state), he transcends the modes of Maya and becomes an absolute devotee of God. Then what would be the position of a person who does not attain absolute superconscious state?'

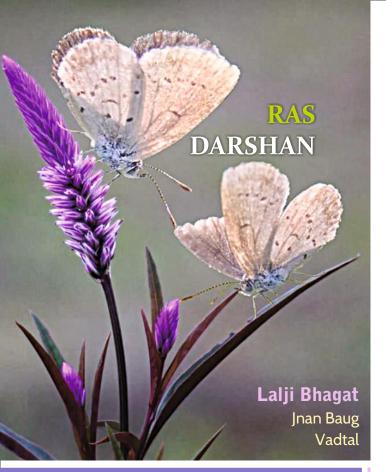
Shreeji Maharaj gave a detailed answer. He said, 'It is not true that absolute superconscious state is attained only when Prana (vital energy) is controlled. Absolute superconscious state can be achieved by another method too.' Then Shreeji Maharaj quoted a verse from Shreemad Bhagvat which said: Shree Krishna Bhagvan, the supreme refuge of all, can be known by nine characteristics including Sarg (invisible creation), Visarg (visible gross creation) etc.. In that form the aspirant may cultivate firm faith.

Saying this, Shreeji Maharaj gave the example of a mango tree. That, once we know that this is a mango tree, then we will not have any illusion or daubt about it. Even when he is lustful, angry or avaricious he would have no illusion about the existence of the mango tree. Similarly a person who has firm faith in Shree Krishna Bhagwan before him would never have any doubt. That would be his superconscious state even when his vital energies are withdrawn or not withdrawn.

Explaining His point further, Shreeji Maharaj said that a person with confused thought about God may be thinking thus: How must be the form of God in Brahmapur, ShwetDweep and Vaikunth? When would he be able to see that form respectfully? He would thus continue his confused thinking. But he would not feel the mission of his life fulfilled by thinking of God before him as the cause of all causes. If, God willing, such a person experiences superconscious state his confused thinking would not end. Even in superconscious state he would desire to see still more and more of new objects but his negative thoughts would not come to an end. The superconscious state achieved by such a person is Savikalp. Even when he is not in superconscious state he would be as good as having a Savikalp - superconscious state because his desire to see more and more of God persists.

Shreeji Maharaj here suggests that - When a person cultivates a firm faith in the form of the Lord, then he would leave his bad nature and feel that for the welfare of his Jiva, Parbrahm Purushottam Narayan descended on this earth and founded this Holy Faith for him, also built big temples Himself for the kalyan of all and Lord Swaminarayan Himself consecrated His archa swarup Moorti. When a devotee believes this firmly, he does not have any illusion. His Moksha is attainable in this Holy Faith easily.

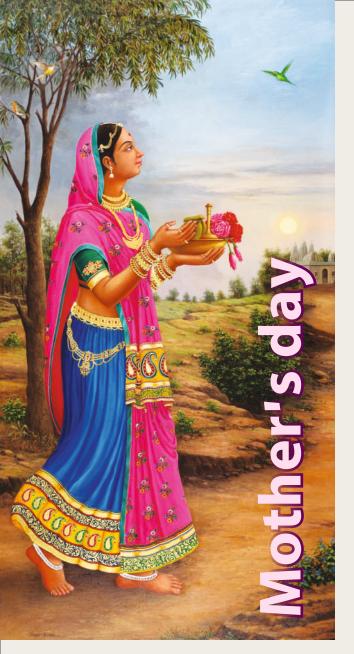

Western researchers reveal why children who memorize sanskrit mantras become super intelligent as they grow up*

Neuroscience shows how rigorous memorising can help the brain. The term the 'Sanskrit Effect' was coined by neuroscientist James Hartzell, who studied 21 professionally qualified Sanskrit pandits. He discovered that memorising Vedic mantras increases the size of brain regions associated with cognitive function, including short and long-term memory. This finding corroborates the beliefs of the Indian tradition which holds that memorising and reciting mantras enhances memory and thinking.

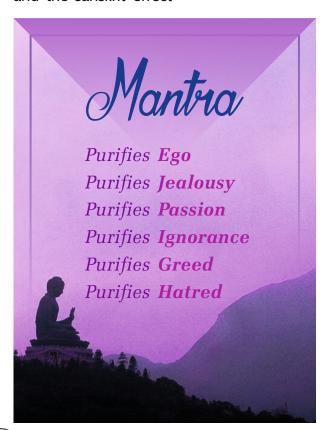
Dr Hartzell's recent study raises the question whether this kind of memorisation of ancient texts could be helpful in reducing the devastating illness of Alzheimer's and other memory affecting diseases. Apparently, Ayurvedic doctors from India suggest it is the case and future studies will be conducted, along with more research into Sanskrit.

While we all know the benefits of mindfulness and meditation practices, the findings of Dr Hartzell are truly dramatic. In a world of shrinking attention spans, where we are flooded with information daily, and children display a range of attention deficit disorders, ancient Indian wisdom has much to

teach the West (and their 'modernised' intellectual serfs in the East).

Even introducing small amounts of chanting and recitation of the common Sanskrit mantras like Gayatri mantra daily could have an amazing effect on all of our brains.

Vidurji was an expert Nitigna, an exponent of moral codes. He was an ideal state minister and a devotee too. In today's terminology, he was a motivational speaker of high celebre.

Neeti has an important place in our society. We try to follow Neeti. Yet, it becomes difficult to follow Neeti in difficult circum-

stances. In difficult c ircumstances, what should be done to follow Neeti is called Neeti Shastra. Lord Swaminarayan accepted Vidurji's Neeti Shastra and recognised it as a Satshastra in Shikshapatri.

Vidurji taught lessons of morality to Dhrutrashtra. Yet he remained aloof from all the quarrels and never allowed himself to be influenced by them. Vidurji showed the ways, gave solutions and established standards of morals. These views are known as Vidur Neeti. Ved Vyasji compiled these concepts, which is known as Vidurji's Neeti Shastra.

Vidurji was the eye-witness of the biggest battle of Hindustan. He was the minister of the state, Hastinapur. The battle was fought between the two families, Kauravas and Pandavas, of that state. He was the uncle of the warring factions. He was a policy maker and true righteous person. So he always spoke about Dharma, Nyaya and ethics. He never wrote these ideals but lived them. His codes of conduct came to be known as Vidur Neeti.

One question arises: How can a policy which was conceptualised 5000 years ago be applicable today? For us, the followers of Swaminarayan Sampraday, Vidur Neeti is

Vidurji was knowledgeable but never enforced his ideas. He merely did his duty. Vidur Neeti is relevant even today.

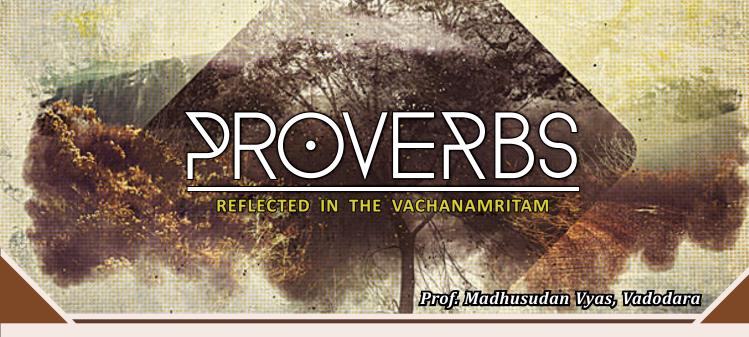

KARIYANI CHAPTER - 7



The Dog of a Washerman belongs neither to House nor to the River Bank



A large religious sermon meeting was held at Kariyani. Many household people, Munis and saints from near and far off states were listening to the Lord. But often questions were thrown on the floor for open discussion. When the people in the meeting failed to arrive at satisfactory solution of the question the Lord had to intervene. There rose a question about the difference between so called fickle, feeble, faltering, fake and temporary acceptance of asceticism and the firm, real, concrete and staunch asceticism. No perfect solution to this question could be found even after many rounds of careful discussion. The Munis requested Shri Hari to throw light on the point. The Lord accepted their request and offered an adequate solution to the problem by citing the proverb regarding the condition of a

washerman's dog, who is bewildered between two points of compass i.e. home and riverbank. He moves between these points like the pendulum in a wall clock. Western philosophy defines this situation as the delusion existing between the two horns of a dilemma. Now let us see, who is that pendulum or the washerman's dog? Indian mythology defines such oscillation as condition of Trishanku. Acceptance of asceticism is one usually by the household, saints, Munis or Paramhansas and the adopter may be Sattvik, Rajasik or Tamasik. The term of acceptance may be (a) purely temporary (b) short lived (c) permanent and well-organised. The permanent and well organized asceticism makes him a firm and staunch ascetic. Whatever may come he does not budge. He is never disturbed or distracted. The Bhagwad Geeta describes this as Brahmi condition of Sthitaprajna. The one whose acceptance of asceticism is purely temporary or tentative drops it off and soon returns to normal material life. The example of washerman's dog applies to the faltering, oscillating acceptance of asceticism. As being tired or disappointed in worldly life the fellow adopts asceticism. Due to immature acceptance his mind moves between freedom

of the soul and worldly desires. He hangs like a pendulum and moves between two points of the compass. He is confused between two voices - one from the soul and other from the body. In order to explain this bewilderment the Lord gives the example of washerman's dog. CHATAKI or click of mind is the main purpose of asceticism. One who receives this type of CHATAKI, click, spur or knack does not return from asceticism. Like the washerman's dog he does not vascilate between home and riverbank. Climax of asceticism remains his final destination. We can call it iconic or spiritual destination. The Lord emphasises the point of strong concrete and solid faith in the acceptance of asceticism. If the washerman's dog returns home to get food and comfort he gets nothing because doors are closed. If an ascetic drops asceticism and returns to worldly life he gets nothing. Therefore total renunciation puts him on the riverbank which functions as his final destination in spiritual progress. Just remember the opposite spelling of GOD is DOG.

Answers to the questions of curious seekers

Pradakshina

(Clock wise circular movement to God's idol)

There are some tools and gestures which please God, Pradakshina is one of them. In Sanskrit, **Dakshin** means right. When you keep on moving to your right side and take (circular) rounds encircling some object, this type of action is called the process of Pradakshina. It is such behaviour which Shriji Maharaj first put into practice and then recommended the same to His devotees.

Shriji Maharaj Himself used to offer two hundred rounds of Pradakshina at Vadtal temple! When a devotee goes to the temple first, he prefers to have Darshan and then offers Pradakshina to the temple. The circular movement gives the idea of circle which always has a center point. Many things and objects, wealth and power in the universe are created and they perish but who is at the center? Who is the center of our life? There is only one answer "The most gracious Lord Swaminarayan."

He is the source behind creation and destruction of this mysterious universe. He nourishes us with the help of five fundamental elements and keeps our life fresh and flowing. So we are extremely obliged to Him. With this thought in mind we offer Pradakshina to Lord Swaminarayan.

The sphere (orbit) may be small or big but its every point remains at equal distance from the center point. The span of life may be of any size but God smiles on us from equal distance at every point of life. This sense of warm awareness regarding blissful presence of God can be possible only through the practice of Pradakshina. If Pradakshina is done with the chanting of holy Mantra Swaminarayan, remembering His life-sports and grace of Lord Swaminarayan, it can create better vibrations in the mind. We may go anywhere on business tour but finally we return home. In the same way, Pradakshina is a means to bring our mind back to the idol of Shriji Maharaj and realize His presence around us. By doing Pradakshina the mind stops wandering and becomes stable in the idol of God.

If we look from psychological point of view, when we enter a temple, our mind is crowded with so many external thoughts. Actions and reactions of routine life disturb the mind. When we get the Darshan of Lord Swaminarayan, the mind is pacified. When we offer Pradakshina, our mind and body get new rhyme and rhythm. Mind and body are refreshed and get associated with God.

Some people are extra careful about counting the number of wounds in doing Pradakshina and some indulge in routine talk during the process. In both the cases, the center or the main function is lost. The purpose of Pradakshina is to associate mind and body in the devotion of God. Stability of mind and better concentration can please the Lord. This is the significance of Pradakshina.

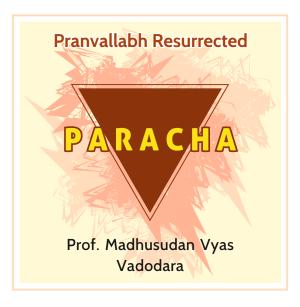

Khadakya kashta ma salvalyu tan, sahu ashcharya pamya mann.

So he agreed to go back into the body. As he decided to return into the same body and returned home, to his surprise he saw

that his relatives had taken the body to the cremation ground for final rites. Wooden planks were arranged as bed. The dead body was placed on it and they were about to light the pyre. One moment before they set fire to the pyre the relatives saw that the dead body showed some movement. They went near and saw that the body was gaining consciousness and coming back to life.

They began to discuss, "The fellow had really died and how has the soul



come back into the body? What a wonder this fellow comes back to life!"

Out of great wonder and amazement they asked Pranvallabh to tell them how it had become possible for him to come back into the body which had been taken to the cremation ground.

Then Pranvallabh said, "I had left this body as I set out to go to the abode."

Aa to kaal no veg chhe bhari, naakhshe nar nari ne mari;

Mano maru etalu vachan, tali padi ne karo Bhajan.

"O good fellows! I have come back to give you one important message. The force of Kala (Yama) is very strong and it will kill all men and women and will take them to hell. If you want to enjoy liberation after death as I have achieved, you just take the name of Lord Swaminarayan. Believe my words. You just clap your hands, chant the name of Lord Swaminarayan and you will be able to cross the ocean of life very happily.

Then as demonstration he sang the Dhun (chanting Mantra while clapping) asked all people present to sing and clap and he, too, sang and clapped hands to accompany the group. He had come back to explain the mystery about his coming back into the body. He had come

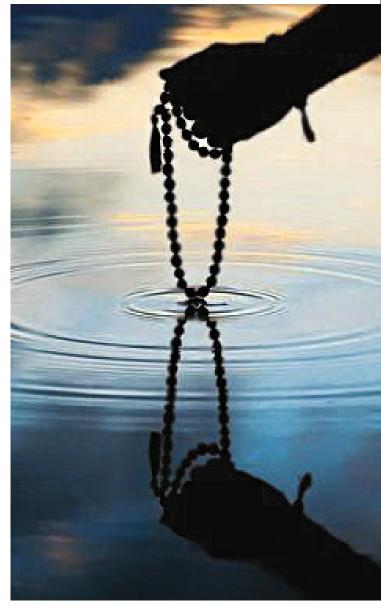

Kavi Dalpatram - Hari Lilamrut

The Swaminarayaniy Poet. Kavi Dalpatram Dahyabhai Travadi. (1820-2020). Bi-centenary Tribute. I have been listening to these lines since my childhood : Janmya Kaushal desh. But a few years ago I came to know that these memorable lines were penned down by Kavi Dalpatram Dahyabhai Travadi. These few lines depict the life story of Sahjanand Swami, perhaps the shortest and finest life-sketch of Sahjanand Swami ever drawn by anybody. Kavi Dalpatram Dahyabhai Travadi, the great Gujarati poet, is basically a true Swaminarayaniy Poet and lived a life as a Swaminarayaniy aashrit. Kavi Dalpatram saw Sahjanand Swami at Gadhada when he was only 8 years old. He remembered the words

spoken by Sahjanand Swami on that day throughout his life; such was the impact of Sahjanand Swami on the poet. His maternal uncle. Premanandbhai. a resident of Gadhada and a follower of Swaminarayan Sampraday, often took Dalpatram to Muli temple for Darshan. Here at the age of 14 Kavi Dalpatram was initiated as a disciple by Bhumanand Swami. Kavi Dalpatram became a Parshad (an initiated one in white clothes, the trainee), stayed at Muli temple



and learnt poetics from Devanand Swami, a Charan by caste and a poet of the Swaminarayan Sampraday. Devanand Swami taught him 'Chhand Shrungar' and 'Bhashabhusan'. Here Dalpatram started writing poems about the festivals celebrated at the temple. Swami Vaishnavanandji, a saint of the temple who had studied the poetics at Bhuj Pathshala, finding the literary traits in Dalpatram provided him two important Manmaniari and Anekarthi and helped him to know his subject. Dalpatram got a real boost when the then Acharya of the northern diocese of the Swaminarayan Sampraday designated Swami Vaishnavanandji and Dalpatram as the poets of the Sampraday. Acharyashri Ayodhyaprasadji Maharaj, after some time, invited Dalpatram at Amdavad and provided him all facility for further study, particularly Sanskrit language. Here Dalpatram learnt prosody from Yoganand Swami, a scholar of the Sampraday. Kavi Dalpatram wrote the first book - Chhapaiya Mahatmay here, staying at Amdavad temple. Kavi Dalpatram lived a life following the principles of Sahjanand Swami and depicted them in his writing. Acharyashri Viharilalji Maharajshri of the Vadtal diocese of the Swaminarayan Sampraday and the Thakor Saheb of Lodhika state Abhesinji, in collaboration of Kavi Dalpatram, created few literary gems of the Swaminarayan Sampraday. At Lodhika, Kavi Dalpatram completed 'Purushottam Charitra', a life - sketch of Sahjanand Swami started by Kaviraj Bhimjibhai of Jamnagar. Here Kavi Dalpatram also edited the poems of Brahmanand Swami - Chhand Ratnavali. Thakor Abhesinji published both the books. Acharyashri Viharilalji Maharajshri invited Kavi at Vadtal and provided all resources to write "Shree Harililamrut", a long poem in four volumes providing biographical details of life and work of Sahjanand Swami. Kavi Dalpatram also wrote a study in poetics -Alankardarsh. Both the books are published by the Vadtal temple. Kavi Dalpatram is known for his pioneering literary services in the field of Gujarati literature. His Swaminarayaniy literary creations are the result of his faith. His firm faith in Lord Swaminarayan is remembered even today and his literary creations still guide those who study Swaminarayan Sampraday and Sahjanand

The Nectar of Divine VICTORY OVER DEATH

Amar pati narnag asur sur, sab Maya ke chera re; Achal niket ek nahi payo, tum bina Dharmkishora re. Mera ek aashra tera re, Dharmkuvar Ghanshyam.

(Premanand Swami)

Indra, the lord of heaven, men, the serpents, demons and gods are all subservient to Maya. None has achieved a steady place, except you. O son of Dharma! O Ghanshyam, You are my only refuge.

The empire of Maya is spread all over the world. All beings, without exception are constantly gripped by the fear of death. But he who resorts to God, the omnipotent, becomes free from the fear of death, because God is above death. This is why when a person is initiated with five fundamental vows (Pancha Vrataman), he declares:

Kaal maya paapkarma, yamadut bhayadaham; Shri Krushnadev sharnam, prapannoasmi sa patu mam.

I have come to the refuge of Shree Krishnadev (God Supreme) because He makes free the devotee from the fear of Death, Maya, sins and the agents of god of death (Yamaduta). May He protect me.

Four types of devotees rise above the fear of death. They are: [1] Devotees with faith in God. [2] Devotees with knowledge about God. [3] Devotees who are brave. [4]

Devotees with absolute and unconditional love for God. All these four types of devotees attain beatitude in this very life. (Vachanamrut Loya - 2).

FAITH

Faith is the first essential characteristic of a devotee. He who has faith has the strength of firm conviction about God. He firmly believes that he would ascend to the abode of God even if he gives up the body while talking or walking, or even when he is devoured by a tiger or a lion. He says to himself: 'I have been with God in person. So, my ambition is fulfilled.' With such firm conviction he leads his life.

Kala Bhagat of Kundaal (North Gujarat) was a devotee who belonged to this category. The jealous members of his family misappropriated his land but Kala Bhagat had unflinching faith in Shreeji Maharaj. He approached the rural judicial committee for justice but this judicial committee had lost the divine voice for pronouncing right judgement. The jealous members of the family of Kala Bhagat had bribed this judicial committee. The judicial committee delivered judgement: 'You will be declared rightful owner of that much land, on which you can walk while holding a red-hot ironball before the public.'

The judgement given by the judicial committee was final and binding to the complainant and the defendant. Who would wait for an invitation to such a show? So all the villagers gathered in a field outside the village. In the fire of the furnace an iron-ball was made red-hot. The jealous members of the family of Kala Bhagat twittered: 'Let us now see what happens to this so called great devotee of God!'

The red-hot-iron-ball was glowing like the rising sun. Seeing this Kala Bhagat earnestly prayed to God: "O dear one, You are my only saviour. Forget me not at this critical juncture." Responding to his earnest prayer, God appeared in this mind and said: "O dear one, be fearless and hold the redhot iron-ball with both the hands. Your hands won't burn!"

The crowd heard words descending from the sky: 'Kala Bhagat, lift the red hot ironball.' And Kala Bhagat lifted the redhot ironball while smiling at the crowd. With red-hot iron-ball in his hand Kala Bhagat walked on the land which rightly belonged to him. Thus he recovered his land by following the judgement of the judicial committee.

Let us go deeper into this incident. All know what would happen if a person lifts a

red-hot iron-ball. But Kala Bhagat had adamant faith in God and he strongly felt that all would be well with him as he had met God in person. He had already been with God who is the ultimate goal of life. So he was above the fear of death and lifted the red-hot iron-ball. His rock like faith brought God there. This incident is presented by Swami Nishkulanand in his poetic composition – Bhakta Chintamani (Ch.137). The descendants of kala Bhagat are still alive and the iron ball is still preserved at Swaminarayan Museum - Amdavad with care!

Therefore, if one has firm faith in God, one would be free from the fear of death.

The genius of Sahjanand Swami was not confined to the rigid re- establishment of Hindu worship in virgin integrity; it was also directed against the irregularities of the age and to the recovery of thousands of those unfortunate men to be found throughout Guiarat whose means of subsistence hitherto were equally lawless and precarious. Of his success in this latter respect, there is abundant testimony from the vast hordes who have been reclaimed to honest and industrious pursuits, while the present undisturbed state of the country compared with its condition previously will speak volumes for him who, at least in this respect, justly earns the appellation of Reformer, apart from those reasons which may be urged of the presence of an equitable British Government and the existence of a moral dread effecting much in this way. The wide latitude, too, which his doctrines comprise - permitting men of all classes to live upto them so long as they are faithfully observed - has materially tended towards Koollees, Kathis, Grassias, Rajputs, and a vast variety of other castes and classes of men rallying under his banner.

In the midst of these philanthropic exertions, while his very name was the guerdon of worth in the length and breadth of the province, surrounded by his friends, his family and his followers, and supported by the learner of those who were his constant companions, he digested and published his Code of Instructions. Sahjanand's subsequent life was one of undisturbed pursuit in the

furtherance of his cause, occasionally traveling through different parts of the country where any large collection of his disciples resided, To instruct and exhort and support them by his personal presence.

n Vadtal temple, the small as well as big idols consecrated in the interior side of the temple dome are not just for decoration but they are living embodiments of dazzling past symbols and are worth for close Darshan and worship, Here is an episode related with it.

Construction work of Vadtal temple was in progress. At that time on the Northern end of the eastern (Roop choki) dais Hiraji Salat (sculpture) was carving the idol of Hanumanji and God was pleased to observe it and offered him a garland as His kind favour. At this time, Brahmanand Swami, came there and reported that Hira Salat had prepared the idols having lovely form, figure and gestures and are meant for putting around in the

interior of the dome, These idols are holding various musical instruments in their hands. Shri Hari felt very happy to see them and said, "What a nice sculpture! Only living cell is lacking in them. If these were alive, there would remain no difference between them and the real idols created by the creator. Brahmanand Swami said, "Yes, what You say is very true. If any God comes here He will fill these idols with life because if God can fondle the idol of blood and flesh why can't He put life in the idols of stone? 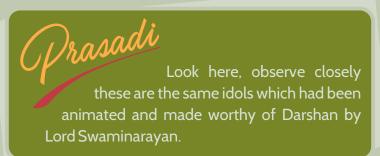
